Deadline: All Applications must be post marked by Friday, April 2, 2010

Grant Award:

- One \$2,500 grant will be awarded to a local small business person based on Martha's Vineyard looking to improve, grow or start a new business. The project or program should be consistent with MVWN's mission to promote economic development on Martha's Vineyard.

Qualifications:

- Existing businesses and start ups may apply.
- Both Martha's Vineyard Women's Network members and non-members may apply. Non-member application fee of \$100 includes a one year membership to the Martha's Vineyard Women's Network.

Application Fee and Deadline

- MVWN Members: There is no application fee for MVWN members.
- Non-Members: For non-members, application fee is \$100 which includes a one year membership in the Martha's Vineyard Women's Network. Checks may be made payable to MVWN and must be included with application.
- All applications must be post marked by Friday, April 2, 2010. All applications should be mailed to:
